with photos for inclusion in *CAO*. Electronic submission of text and photos is preferred. The deadline for *CAO* submissions is the 28th of the month preceding publication.

Postings

Postings is a weekly e-newsletter geared to convey information from the diocesan office to clergy, church offices, wardens, vestries, ministry groups other and church leaders.

It includes announcements about diocesan events, meetings and deadlines, as well as information relevant to church programming, etc. At the discretion of the editor, information provided by congregations and ministry groups may also be included when it is of importance to the entire diocese. The deadline for submissions to *Postings* is 5 p.m. every Monday. Such submissions must be made electronically.

The Diocese provides an online events calendar as part of www.episcopalwny.org. This calendar lists events and meetings sponsored by the diocese and special events sponsored by its churches, as well as meetings and events of various ministry groups associated with the diocese, such as Cursillo, The Order of St. Luke, etc.

Churches and ministry groups are responsible for the posting their own events to the calendar. Each church or group may authorize up to three people to take on this responsibility for their church or group.
